You would be able to choose any nights, starting Friday, July 21 until Sunday, July 23. On Monday, the National Guard Armory will be closing at 11:00 a.m. and all booths must be picked up by this time. Most booths will be open from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. each night. You are welcome to be open more if you choose.

©Commercial Booths - There will be a \$10.00 charge for these booths inside the armory and \$25.00 for booths set up outside. You would be able to choose any nights, starting Friday, July 21 until Sunday, July 23.
