Check with your local Post Rock District Office and your 4-H Club to learn about any **camp scholarships** available.

**Transportation** to and from camp will be provided.

**Post Rock District staff** will chaperone our campers while at camp. This year they are Aliesa Woods, Ashley Svaty, and Risa Overmiller.

**Campers must be 7-12** years old (as of Jan. 1) and a current 4-H member in Jewell, Lincoln, Mitchell, Osborne, or Smith County. You must be enrolled on 4-HOnline prior to registering for camp.

A current **Kansas 4-H Participation Form** must be completed on 4-H online.

**The 2019 Camp Fee** includes camp, housing, meals, activities, and Dairy Queen lunch. Camp fees must be paid in full to your local 4-H Council by June 1<sup>st</sup>. \$50.00 is non-refundable after May 1st. The total camp fee is non-refundable after June 1<sup>st</sup>.

A **camp packet** with planning and packing information will be mailed to each registered camper in early June.
