Campers must be 7-12 years old (as of Jan. 1) and a current 4-H member in Jewell, Lincoln, Mitchell, Osborne, or Smith County. You must be enrolled on 4-HOnline prior to registering for camp.

A current **Kansas 4-H Participation Form** must be completed on 4-H online.

The **2021 Camp Fee** includes camp, housing, meals, activities, and lunch. Camp fees must be paid in full to your local 4-H Council by May 15th.

A **camp packet** with planning and packing information will be mailed to each registered camper in early June.



Check with your local Post Rock District Office and your 4-H Club to learn about any **camp scholarships** available.

Transportation to and from camp will be provided.
