| MATERIAL – Suitable for age and occasion. Should meet standards and ideals of 4-H. | 10 | |
| INTRODUCTION – Presentations should begin with a short 15-45 second introduction (in addition to reading time) describing reading title, author and why reading was selected. Interesting, short and gains attention. | 20 | |
| PRESENTATION – Voice natural, words distinct, poised, friendly, and confident. Time and material well used. Originality shown. Convincing, interest held. Well organized, words well chosen. Skillful workmanship. Non-verbal and verbal communication coordinate. Plain view of audience. Neat and orderly. | 30 | |
| INTERPRETATION – The meaning or point of the reading brought out by the participant and the degree to which the audience realized it. | 15 | |
| VISUALS AND EQUIPMENT – No visual aids allowed; however the participant is to present with the book/binder of reading in-hand. Support presentation and do not distract from participant. | 15 | |
| APPEARANCE – Dressed suitable for work being done. Well groomed, good posture. | 10 | |
