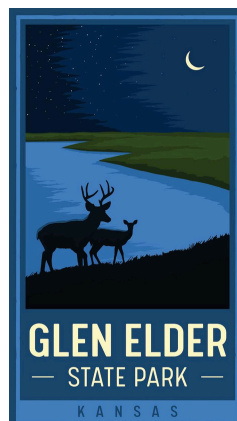
May is Walking Month! **Join us at Glen Elder State Park's Walking Trails**

- 3 Loop Options (1.5 mile, 2.1 miles, 3.6 miles)
- Difficulty Level: Easy
- Trail Surface: Natural Prairie

All trail loops start and end at the Glen Elder State Park main office. Trails travel past a fishing pond, cross through several small wooded areas with wildlife and provide access to the Waconda Springs replica. Trail is open to hiking and bicycling. Vehicle permit not required on day of event. Parking for the trail is at the main park office.
